2	relating to scholarship and insurance payments for student athletes
3	at certain public institutions of higher education.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 51.9246 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 51.9246. SCHOLARSHIP AND INSURANCE PAYMENTS FOR
8	CERTAIN STUDENT ATHLETES. (a) In this section, "media rights"
9	means the rights to media coverage of intercollegiate athletics
10	included in contracts between intercollegiate athletic conferences
11	and television networks that generate monetary payments to
12	individual institutions of higher education.
13	(b) This section applies only to an institution of higher
14	education that receives an average of at least \$10 million in annual
15	revenue derived from media rights.
16	(c) If the athletic program of an institution of higher
17	education to which this section applies does not renew the athletic
18	scholarship of a student athlete who suffers an incapacitating
19	injury or illness resulting from the student athlete's
20	participation in the athletic program and is determined to be
21	medically ineligible to participate in intercollegiate athletics,
22	the institution shall award to the student athlete a scholarship in
23	an amount that, when combined with the amount of the scholarship
24	funds previously awarded to the student athlete by the institution,

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1 will cover the costs of tuition and mandatory fees for the student athlete's enrollment in the institution for a period of four 2 3 academic years or the period required for the student athlete to complete the student athlete's undergraduate degree, whichever 4 period is shorter. An institution may award a scholarship under 5 this subsection for a period longer than otherwise required by this 6 7 subsection. (d) The athletic program of an institution of higher 8 education to which this section applies shall, for the duration of 9 the period in which a student athlete is participating in the 10 athletic program, pay premiums for health insurance that covers 11 12 claims resulting from the student athlete's participation in the athletic program for the student athlete if the student athlete's 13

14 <u>household income is below the level established by the Texas Higher</u> 15 <u>Education Coordinating Board for purposes of this subsection.</u>

16 (e) Subject to Subsection (f), the athletic program of an 17 institution of higher education to which this section applies shall 18 pay any deductible required under a student athlete's insurance 19 policy for a claim made by the student athlete for an injury or 20 illness resulting from the student athlete's participation in the 21 athletic program.

(f) If a student athlete participating in an athletic program of an institution of higher education to which this section applies suffers an injury or illness resulting from the student athlete's participation that requires ongoing treatment, the athletic program shall provide, for the duration of the period in which the student athlete is enrolled at the institution and for a

5 (2) payment for insurance premiums and any required 6 deductible under an insurance plan for the student athlete that 7 covers treatment for the student athlete's injury or illness.

8 (g) An institution of higher education to which this section 9 applies may use only revenue derived from media rights to pay a cost 10 associated with the requirements of this section.

11 SECTION 2. (a) Section 51.9246(c), Education Code, as 12 added by this Act, applies beginning with athletic scholarships 13 awarded by an institution of higher education for the 2015-2016 14 academic year.

(b) Section 51.9246(d), Education Code, as added by this Act, applies to insurance premium payments for a student athlete participating in the athletic program of an institution of higher education on or after January 1, 2016.

(c) Section 51.9246(e), Education Code, as added by this Act, applies to an insurance claim made by a student athlete on or after the effective date of this Act.

(d) Section 51.9246(f), Education Code, as added by this
Act, applies to an injury or illness that occurs on or after the
effective date of this Act.

25 SECTION 3. Not later than December 31, 2015, the Texas 26 Higher Education Coordinating Board shall establish the threshold 27 household income to be used for purposes of Section 51.9246(d),

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1 Education Code, as added by this Act.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
