5	SECTION 1. Section 614.013, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
7	(b-1) The methods established under Subsection (b):
8	(1) must ensure that each offender with a mental
9	impairment is identified and qualified for the continuity of care
10	and service program regardless of diagnosis; and
11	(2) may not restrict access to the continuity of care
12	and service program or services to those offenders who have been

13 <u>diagnosed with specific mental disorders.</u>

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
