A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the enforcement of certain local traffic laws on the campus of a public or private institution of higher education. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.203(b), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) Within a peace officer's primary jurisdiction, a peace officer commissioned under this section: 8 9 (1) is vested with all the powers, privileges, and immunities of peace officers; 10 11 (2) may, in accordance with Chapter 14, Code of 12 Criminal Procedure, arrest without a warrant any person who violates a law of the state; and 13 14 (3) may enforce all traffic laws on streets and highways, including a municipal traffic ordinance relating to the 15 16 use of a wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle. 17 18 SECTION 2. Section 51.212(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 The governing boards of private institutions of higher 20 (a) education, including private junior colleges, are authorized to 21 employ and commission peace officers for the purpose of enforcing: 22 23 (1)with respect to [state law on] the campuses of 24 private institutions of higher education:

1 (A) state law; and 2 (B) a municipal traffic ordinance relating to the use of a wireless communication device while operating a motor 3 4 vehicle; and 5 law, including (2) state and local applicable 6 municipal ordinances, at other locations, as permitted by Subsection (b) or Section 51.2125. 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11

12 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
