1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the payment in certain counties of expenses associated  
 1-22 with the transportation of senior citizens and their caregivers for  
 1-23 civic, community, educational, and recreational activities.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 615.022, Local Government Code, is  
 1-26 amended to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 615.022. TRANSPORTATION EXPENSES OF CERTAIN COUNTIES  
 1-28 FOR SENIOR CITIZENS. The commissioners court of a county with a  
 1-29 population of 2.2 [~~3.3~~] million or more may pay out of the county  
 1-30 general funds costs and expenses for the transportation of senior  
 1-31 citizens and their caregivers for civic, community, educational,  
 1-32 and recreational activities within and outside the county if a  
 1-33 majority of the costs and expenses paid are for the transportation  
 1-34 of senior citizens.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
