- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 41.102, Agriculture Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 41.102. SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF LICENSE. In
- 7 addition to other remedies provided by law, a violation of any
- 8 provision of Subchapters B-E or H [of this chapter] is grounds for
- 9 suspension or revocation of any license or permit issued by the
- 10 commissioner. The suspension or revocation shall be conducted in
- 11 accordance with the procedures provided by law for suspension or
- 12 revocation on the basis of other grounds.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 41, Agriculture Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 41.1565 to read as follows:
- Sec. 41.1565. MEETINGS BY TELEPHONE CONFERENCE CALL. (a)
- 16 Notwithstanding Chapter 551, Government Code, the council may hold
- 17 an open or closed meeting by telephone conference call if the
- 18 convening at one location of a quorum of the council is inconvenient
- 19 for any member of the council.
- 20 (b) The meeting is subject to the notice requirements
- 21 applicable to other meetings.
- (c) The notice of the meeting must specify as the location
- 23 of the meeting the location where meetings of the council are
- 24 <u>usually</u> held.

- 1 (d) Each part of the meeting that is required to be open to
- 2 the public shall be audible to the public at the location specified
- 3 in the notice of the meeting as the location of the meeting and
- 4 shall be tape recorded. The tape recording shall be made available
- 5 to the public.
- 6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 7 41.102, Agriculture Code, applies only to conduct that occurs on or
- 8 after the effective date of this Act. Conduct that occurs before the
- 9 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 10 date the conduct occurs, and the former law is continued in effect
- 11 for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
