Section 43.106, Local Government Code, 4 is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 43.106. ANNEXATION OF COUNTY ROADS REQUIRED IN CERTAIN 7 CIRCUMSTANCES. (a) A municipality that proposes to annex any portion of a [paved] county road or territory that abuts a county 8 road must also annex the entire width of the county road and the 9 adjacent right-of-way on both sides of the county road. 10 11 (b) If a road annexed under Subsection (a) is a gravel road, 12 the county retains control of granting access to the road and its right-of-way from property that: 13 14 (1) is not located in the boundaries of the annexing municipality; and 15 16 (2) is adjacent to the road and right-of-way. SECTION 2. Section 43.106, Local Government Code, as 17 amended by this Act, applies to an area proposed for annexation on 18 or after the effective date of this Act or before the effective date 19 20 of this Act if the statutory requirements for annexation under 21 Subchapter C or C-1, Chapter 43, Local Government Code, have not been completed before the effective date of this Act. 22 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
