5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Title 7, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended by
7	adding Chapter 290 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 290. CHAMBERS, JEFFERSON, GALVESTON, HARDIN, NEWTON, AND
9	ORANGE COUNTIES
10	Sec. 290.001. BAG LIMIT EXEMPTIONS FOR CERTAIN FISHING
11	TOURNAMENTS. (a) In this section, "fishing tournament" has the
12	meaning assigned by Section 66.023.
13	(b) This section applies to a fishing tournament held on the
14	southern stretches of the Sabine or Neches River, in the Gulf
15	Intracoastal Waterway, or in the Gulf of Mexico as those bodies of
16	water lie within or are adjacent to the following counties:
17	(1) Chambers County;
18	(2) Jefferson County;
19	(3) Galveston County;
20	(4) Hardin County;
21	(5) Newton County; and
22	(6) Orange County.
23	(c) A participant in a fishing tournament who is part of a
24	team affiliated with a college or high school may count toward the

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participant's bag limit for largemouth bass a fish that is smaller than the applicable size limit by not more than two inches.

3 (d) A fish counted under this section must be released after
4 weighing.

5 SECTION 2. Chapter 290, Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by 6 this Act, applies only to a fishing tournament held on or after the 7 effective date of this Act.

8 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 9 10 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 11 12 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 13 14 Government Code.

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on Province Provinc

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 18 (c) 19 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 20 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives within the required time. 21

(d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled and accomplished.

26 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
