AN ACT

- 2 relating to limitations on the capture or possession of a biometric
- 3 identifier by a governmental body.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 560.001(1), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:

- 7 (1) "Biometric identifier" means a <u>blood sample</u>, hair
- 8 sample, skin sample, DNA sample, body scan, retina or iris scan,
- 9 fingerprint, voiceprint, or record of hand or face geometry.
- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 560, Government Code, is amended by
- 11 adding Section 560.0015 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 560.0015. STATUTORY AUTHORITY REQUIRED. A
- 13 governmental body may not capture or possess a biometric identifier
- 14 of an individual unless the governmental body has:
- 15 (1) specific, explicit statutory authority to capture
- 16 or possess the individual's biometric identifier; or
- 17 (2) the written consent of the individual or the
- 18 <u>individual's legal guardian.</u>
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 560.0015, Government Code, as added by
- 20 this Act, applies only to a biometric identifier captured on or
- 21 after the effective date of this Act. A biometric identifier
- 22 captured before that date is governed by the law in effect
- 23 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 24 continued in effect for that purpose.

1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
