A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to entrance examinations for applicants for beginning

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 143.025, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (f-1) and amending Subsection (i) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (f-1) An additional five points may be added to the
- 9 examination grade of an applicant for a beginning position in the
- 10 police department who successfully completed a career and technical
- 11 education program in criminal justice that is:
- 12 (1) approved by the State Board of Education; and
- 13 (2) offered by a high school located in the
- 14 municipality in which the applicant is seeking employment.
- 15 (i) The grade to be placed on the eligibility list for each
- 16 applicant shall be computed by adding an applicant's points under
- 17 Subsection (f) and (f-1), if any, to the applicant's grade on the
- 18 written examination. Each applicant's grade on the written
- 19 examination is based on a maximum grade of 100 percent and is
- 20 determined entirely by the correctness of the applicant's answers
- 21 to the questions. The minimum passing grade on the examination is 70
- 22 percent. An applicant must pass the examination to be placed on an
- 23 eligibility list.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
