1-17 relating to the recycling of county surplus or salvage property.
1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-19 SECTION 1. Section [263.152](#), Local Government Code, is
1-20 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
1-21 (c) Disposal under Subsection (a)(3) may be accomplished
1-22 through a recycling program under which the property is collected,
1-23 separated, or processed and returned to use in the form of raw
1-24 materials in the production of new products.
1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
