- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 773, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 773.0496 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 773.0496. SCOPE OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL
- 8 TECHNICIAN-PARAMEDIC AND LICENSED PARAMEDIC DUTIES. (a) In this
- 9 section:
- 10 (1) "Advanced life support" means health care provided
- 11 to sustain life in an emergency, life-threatening situation. The
- 12 term includes the initiation of intravenous therapy, endotracheal
- 13 or esophageal intubation, electrical cardiac defibrillation or
- 14 cardioversion, and drug therapy procedures.
- 15 (2) "Direct supervision" means supervision of an
- 16 emergency medical technician-paramedic or licensed paramedic by a
- 17 licensed physician who is present in the same area or an area
- 18 adjacent to the area where an emergency medical
- 19 technician-paramedic or licensed paramedic performs a procedure
- 20 and who is immediately available to provide assistance and
- 21 direction during the performance of the procedure.
- (b) Notwithstanding other law, a person who is certified
- 23 under this chapter as an emergency medical technician-paramedic or
- 24 a licensed paramedic, is acting under the delegation and direct

- 1 supervision of a licensed physician, and is authorized to provide
- 2 advanced life support by a health care facility may in accordance
- 3 with department rules provide advanced life support in the
- 4 facility's emergency or urgent care clinical setting, including a
- 5 hospital emergency room and a freestanding emergency medical care
- 6 facility.
- 7 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 8 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 9 Services Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
- 10 Section 773.0496, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
