 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the maximum capacity of a container of wine sold to a
 1-20 retail dealer; amending a provision subject to a criminal penalty.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 101.45, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 101.45. CONTAINERS OF WINE: MAXIMUM CAPACITY. A
 1-25 person may not sell wine to a retail dealer in a container with a
 1-26 capacity greater than 15.5 [~~eight~~] gallons.

1-27 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
 1-28 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
 1-29 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
 1-30 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
 1-31 before that date.

1-32 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
 1-33 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
 1-34 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-35 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
