4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 109.57(d), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(d) This section does not affect the authority of a
8	governmental entity to regulate, in a manner as otherwise permitted
9	by law, the location of:
10	(1) a massage parlor, nude modeling studio, or other
11	sexually oriented business; [or]
12	(2) an establishment that derives 75 percent or more
13	of the establishment's gross revenue from the on-premise sale of
14	alcoholic beverages <u>; or</u>
15	(3) an establishment that:
16	(A) derives 50 percent or more of the
17	establishment's gross revenue from the on-premise sale of alcoholic
18	beverages; and
19	(B) is located in a municipality or county, any
20	portion of which is located not more than 50 miles from an
21	international border.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
