5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 114, Health and Safety Code, is amended
7	by adding Section 114.009 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 114.009. NUTRITION AND PHYSICAL ACTIVITY GUIDELINES
9	FOR CHILD-CARE PROVIDERS. (a) The council shall develop wellness
10	guidelines to educate licensed child-care providers, public school
11	teachers, and public school administrators about serving as role
12	models for children by:
13	(1) practicing healthy nutrition; and
14	(2) engaging in physical activity.

- 15 (b) The council shall develop incentives to encourage
- 16 licensed child-care providers, public school teachers, and public
- 17 school administrators to follow the guidelines.
- 18 <u>(c) The council shall communicate the guidelines and</u>
- 19 <u>incentives</u> to licensed child-care providers, public school
- 20 teachers, and public school administrators in this state in a
- 21 manner that the council determines is appropriate.
- 22 SECTION 2. The interagency obesity council shall develop
- 23 the guidelines and incentives required by Sections 114.009(a) and
- 24 (b), Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, not later than

- 1 January 1, 2016. The council shall communicate the guidelines and
- 2 incentives as required by Section 114.009(c), as added by this Act,
- 3 not later than July 1, 2016.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
