A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to authorizing the issuance of revenue bonds to fund an
- 3 interdisciplinary engineering and academic studies building at The
- 4 University of Texas Rio Grande Valley.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 55.17827 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 55.17827. THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SYSTEM; ADDITIONAL
- 9 BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted by this
- 10 <u>subchapter</u>, the board of regents of The University of Texas System
- 11 may acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate, enlarge, or
- 12 equip property and facilities, including roads and related
- 13 <u>infrastructure</u>, for an interdisciplinary engineering and academic
- 14 studies building at The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley to be
- 15 financed through the issuance of bonds in accordance with this
- 16 subchapter, including bonds issued in accordance with a systemwide
- 17 revenue financing program and secured as provided by that program,
- 18 <u>in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$42.5 million.</u>
- 19 <u>(b) The board may pledge irrevocably to the payment of bonds</u>
- 20 <u>authorized by this section all or any part of the revenue funds of</u>
- 21 an institution, branch, or entity of The University of Texas
- 22 System, including student tuition charges. The amount of a pledge
- 23 made under this subsection may not be reduced or abrogated while the
- 24 bonds for which the pledge is made, or bonds issued to refund those

- 1 bonds, are outstanding.
- 2 (c) If sufficient funds are not available to the board to
- 3 <u>meet its obligations under this section</u>, the board may transfer
- 4 funds among institutions, branches, and entities of The University
- 5 of Texas System to ensure the most equitable and efficient
- 6 allocation of available resources for each institution, branch, or
- 7 entity to carry out its duties and purposes.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect any authority or
- 9 restriction regarding the activities that a public institution of
- 10 higher education may conduct in connection with a facility financed
- 11 by bonds authorized by this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
