H.B. No. 2109

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to public school performance ratings.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 39.054, Education Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as 6 follows:

The commissioner shall adopt rules to evaluate school 7 (a) district and campus performance and assign each district and campus 8 9 a performance rating of A, B, C, D, or F. In adopting rules under this subsection, the commissioner shall determine the criteria for 10 each designated letter performance rating. A district or campus 11 12 performance rating of A reflects exemplary performance. A district or campus performance rating of B reflects recognized performance. 13 14 <u>A district or campus performance rating of</u> [, B, or] C reflects acceptable performance. A [and a] district or campus performance 15 16 rating of D or F reflects unacceptable performance. [The 17 commissioner shall also assign each campus a performance rating of exemplary, recognized, acceptable, or unacceptable. A campus 18 performance rating of exemplary, recognized, or acceptable 19 reflects acceptable performance, and a campus performance rating of 20 21 unacceptable reflects unacceptable performance.] A district may not receive a performance rating of A if the district includes any 22 23 campus with a performance rating of \underline{D} or \underline{F} [unacceptable]. А reference in law to an acceptable rating or acceptable performance 24

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1 includes a performance rating of A or B or exemplary or recognized
2 performance.

3 <u>(a-1)</u> Not later than August 8 of each year, the performance 4 rating of each district and campus shall be made publicly available 5 as provided by rules adopted under this <u>section</u> [subsection]. If a 6 district or campus received a performance rating <u>of D or F</u> [that 7 reflected unacceptable performance] for the preceding school year, 8 the commissioner shall notify the district of a subsequent such 9 designation on or before June 15.

10 SECTION 2. Section 44(b), Chapter 211 (H.B. 5), Acts of the 11 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, is repealed.

SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016 school year.

14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
