 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the initial inspection period for motor vehicles  
 1-21 purchased by certain commercial fleet buyers.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 548.102(a), Transportation Code, is  
 1-24 amended to read as follows:

1-25 (a) The initial inspection period is two years for a  
 1-26 passenger car or light truck that:

1-27 (1) is sold in this state or purchased by a commercial  
 1-28 fleet buyer described by Section 501.0234(b)(4) for use in this  
 1-29 state;

1-30 (2) has not been previously registered in this or  
 1-31 another state; and

1-32 (3) on the date of sale is of the current or preceding  
 1-33 model year.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
