A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to participation of the state military forces in the state group benefits program. 3

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4

5 SECTION 1. Section 437.212, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsections (f) and (g) and adding Subsection (f-1) to 6 read as follows: 7

A member of the state military forces [volunteer in the 8 (f) 9 Texas State Guard] who is not a full-time or part-time state employee and who has been on state active duty or on state training 10 11 or other duty for more than 60 [90] days is, notwithstanding Section 12 1551.1055, Insurance Code, eligible to participate in the state group benefits program under Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, and is 13 14 considered to be a full-time state employee for the purposes of that chapter, including the receipt of a full state contribution for [to 15 purchase health or dental] insurance coverage, subject to 16 Subsection (f-1) and the following requirements: 17

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(1)the participant must be a member of the state military forces [Texas State Guard] at the time of enrollment in the 19 group benefits program; and 20

21 (2) [the participant must pay the full cost of health 22 or dental insurance coverage under the group benefits program and 23 may not receive a state contribution for premiums; and

24 [(3)] an application under this subsection for [group

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1 benefit health or dental] insurance coverage must be submitted in 2 accordance with procedures established by the Employees Retirement 3 System of Texas.

4 (f-1) The department may require payment of the cost 5 associated with paying the state contribution of a service member who elects to participate in the state group benefits program under 6 Subsection (f) by the person responsible for paying for the mission 7 for which the service member is on state active duty or state 8 training and other duty. The department shall reimburse the board 9 of trustees of the Employees Retirement System of Texas for that 10 cost. 11

12 (g) The adjutant general and the Employees Retirement 13 System of Texas shall coordinate and consult to implement the 14 benefits program provided by Subsection (f) and shall adopt a 15 memorandum of understanding to establish:

(1) the procedures that a member of the <u>state military</u>
<u>forces</u> [Texas State Guard] may use to elect to participate in the
state group benefits program; [and]

19 (2) an appropriate method to annually confirm 20 continuing eligibility to participate in the group benefits 21 program<u>; and</u>

22 (3) an appropriate method of administering the 23 reimbursement of the state contribution as required by Subsection 24 (f-1).

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016.

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
