- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 437.212, Government Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsections (f) and (g) and adding Subsection (f-1) to
- 7 read as follows:

- 8 (f) A member of the state military forces [volunteer in the
- 9 Texas State Guard] who is not a full-time or part-time state
- 10 employee and who has been on state active duty or on state training
- 11 or other duty for more than 60 [90] days is, notwithstanding Section
- 12 <u>1551.1055</u>, Insurance Code, eligible to participate in the state
- 13 group benefits program under Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, and is
- 14 considered to be a full-time state employee for the purposes of that
- 15 chapter, including the receipt of a full state contribution for [to
- 16 purchase health or dental] insurance coverage, subject to
- 17 Subsection (f-1) and the following requirements:
- 18 (1) the participant must be a member of the <u>state</u>
- 19 military forces [Texas State Guard] at the time of enrollment in the
- 20 group benefits program; and
- 21 (2) [the participant must pay the full cost of health
- 22 or dental insurance coverage under the group benefits program and
- 23 may not receive a state contribution for premiums; and
- 24 [(3)] an application under this subsection for [group

- 1 benefit health or dental] insurance coverage must be submitted in
- 2 accordance with procedures established by the Employees Retirement
- 3 System of Texas.
- 4 (f-1) The division of the state military forces that calls a
- 5 member of the state military forces to state active duty or state
- 6 training and other duty is responsible for the cost of the state
- 7 contribution of that member if the member elects to participate in
- 8 the state group benefits program under Subsection (f). The
- 9 division shall reimburse the board of trustees of the Employees
- 10 Retirement System of Texas for that cost.
- 11 (g) The adjutant general and the Employees Retirement
- 12 System of Texas shall coordinate and consult to implement the
- 13 benefits program provided by Subsection (f) and shall adopt a
- 14 memorandum of understanding to establish:
- 15 (1) the procedures that a member of the <u>state military</u>
- 16 forces [Texas State Guard] may use to elect to participate in the
- 17 state group benefits program; [and]
- 18 (2) an appropriate method to annually confirm
- 19 continuing eligibility to participate in the group benefits
- 20 program; and
- 21 (3) an appropriate method of administering the
- 22 reimbursement of the state contribution as required by Subsection
- 23 (f-1).
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016.
