In this subchapter, 11 12 "governmental entity" means a state agency, a county, or a 13 municipality. 14 SECTION 3. Section 614.051, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 15 Sec. 614.051. PURCHASE OF FIREARM BY HONORABLY RETIRED 16 PEACE OFFICER. (a) An individual may purchase a firearm from a 17 governmental entity [state agency] if: 18 (1) the individual was a peace officer commissioned by 19 the entity [agency]; 20 21 (2) the individual was honorably retired from the 22 individual's commission by the entity [state]; (3) the firearm had been previously issued to the 23 24 individual by the entity [agency]; and

(4) the firearm is not a prohibited weapon under
 Section 46.05, Penal Code.

3 (b) An individual may purchase only one firearm from a
4 governmental entity [state agency] under this section.

5 SECTION 4. Section 614.052(a), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:

7 (a) An individual listed under Subsection (b) may purchase a
8 firearm from a <u>governmental entity</u> [state agency] if:

9 (1) the firearm had been previously issued by the 10 <u>entity</u> [agency] to a peace officer commissioned by the <u>entity</u> 11 [agency] who died while commissioned, without regard to whether the 12 officer died while discharging the officer's official duties; and

13 (2) the firearm is not a prohibited weapon under14 Section 46.05, Penal Code.

15 SECTION 5. Section 614.053, Government Code, is amended to 16 read as follows:

Sec. 614.053. PURCHASE PRICE OF FIREARM. A <u>governmental</u> <u>entity</u> [state agency] shall establish the amount, which may not exceed fair market value, for which a firearm may be purchased under this subchapter.

21 SECTION 6. The heading to Section 614.054, Government Code,22 is amended to read as follows:

23 Sec. 614.054. WHEN FIREARM MAY BE PURCHASED [FROM STATE 24 ACENCY]; DELAY OF SALE BY <u>GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY</u> [AGENCY].
