## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to signature verification on an early voting ballot voted
- 3 by mail.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 87.041, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (e-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (e) In making the determination under Subsection (b)(2),
- 9 the board may also compare the signatures with any two or more
- 10 signatures of the voter made within the preceding six years and on
- 11 file with the general custodian of election records or voter
- 12 registrar to <u>determine if</u> [confirm that] the signatures are those
- 13 of the same person [but may not use the signatures to determine that
- 14 the signatures are not those of the same person].
- 15 (e-1) In making the determination under Subsection (b)(2),
- 16 the board may also compare the signatures with any two or more
- 17 signatures of the voter made before the preceding six years and on
- 18 file with the general custodian of election records or voter
- 19 registrar to confirm that the signatures are those of the same
- 20 person but may not use the signatures to determine that the
- 21 signatures are not those of the same person.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
