1-18 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to designating the Interstate Highway 45 causeway to
 1-21 Galveston the George and Cynthia Mitchell Memorial Causeway.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-24 is amended by adding Section 225.103 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 225.103. GEORGE AND CYNTHIA MITCHELL MEMORIAL
 1-26 CAUSEWAY. (a) The structure on Interstate Highway 45 that connects
 1-27 Galveston Island to the Texas mainland and is commonly known as the
 1-28 Galveston Causeway is designated as the George and Cynthia Mitchell
 1-29 Memorial Causeway. The designation is in addition to any other
 1-30 designation.

1-31 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-32 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-33 designation as the George and Cynthia Mitchell Memorial Causeway
 1-34 and any other appropriate information; and

1-35 (2) erect a marker at each end of the causeway.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
