A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to suicide prevention training for certain educators and
- 3 other employees of a school district.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Jason Flatt Act in
- 6 memory of Jonathan Childers.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 161.325(c-2), Health and Safety Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (c-2) If a school district provides [the] training under
- 10 Subsection (c-1), the training must specifically address the
- 11 prevention of youth suicide, and[+
- 12 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ a school district employee described under that
- 13 subsection must participate in the training at least <u>once annually</u>
- 14 [one time; and
- 15 [(2) the school district shall maintain records that
- 16 include the name of each district employee who participated in the
- 17 training].

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- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 19 school year.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
