## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to suicide prevention training for certain educators and
- 3 other employees of a school district.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Suicide Prevention
- 6 Training Act in memory of Jonathan Childers.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 161.325(c-2), Health and Safety Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (c-2) If a school district provides [the] training under
- 10 Subsection (c-1), [ $\div$
- 11  $\left[\frac{1}{2}\right]$  a school district employee described under that
- 12 subsection must participate in the training at least once annually
- 13 [one time; and
- 14 [(2) the school district shall maintain records that
- 15 include the name of each district employee who participated in the
- 16 training].
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
