A county tax 8 9 assessor-collector in a county described by Section 520.052, Transportation Code, is entitled to obtain from the department 10 11 criminal history record information maintained by the department 12 that relates to a person who is an applicant for a motor vehicle title service license issued under Subchapter E, Chapter 520, 13 14 Transportation Code. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
