## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to access to criminal history record information by a county tax assessor-collector. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 411, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 411.14065 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 411.14065. ACCESS TO CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION: COUNTY TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR. A county tax 8 assessor-collector is entitled to obtain from the department 9 criminal history record information maintained by the department 10 11 that relates to a person who is an applicant for a motor vehicle 12 title service license issued under Subchapter E, Chapter 520, Transportation Code. 13 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16
