A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the availability of free prekindergarten programs in
- 3 public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. In 2005, I filed a version of this bill because I
- 6 strongly believe in the need for early child education. I along
- 7 with millions of other children who were born into families with
- 8 adequate means have benefitted from the great advantage that
- 9 pre-kindergarten education provides, and I will continue my efforts
- 10 to make sure that these advantages are available to everyone.
- 11 Ensuring that all Texas children receive the benefit of early
- 12 childhood education is an important part of securing the future of
- 13 this state.
- SECTION 2. Sections 29.153(a) and (b), Education Code, are
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) A district shall offer prekindergarten classes if the
- 17 district identifies 15 or more children who are [eligible under
- 18 Subsection (b) and are at least four years of age. A school
- 19 district may offer prekindergarten classes if the district
- 20 identifies 15 or more eligible children who are at least three years
- 21 of age. A district may not charge tuition for a prekindergarten
- 22 class offered under this section.
- 23 (b) A child is eligible for enrollment in a prekindergarten
- 24 class under this section if the child is:

- 1 (1) at least three years of age and is:
- 2 (A) $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ unable to speak and comprehend the
- 3 English language;
- 4 (B) [(2)] educationally disadvantaged; or
- 5 (C) $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$ homeless, as defined by 42 U.S.C.
- 6 Section 11302, regardless of the residence of the child, of either
- 7 parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or other person
- 8 having lawful control of the child; or
- 9 (2) at least four years of age.
- SECTION 3. Section 29.1532(c), Education Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (c) A school district that offers prekindergarten classes
- 13 shall include the following information in the district's Public
- 14 Education Information Management System (PEIMS) report:
- 15 (1) demographic information, as determined by the
- 16 commissioner, on students enrolled in district prekindergarten
- 17 classes, including the number of students who are eligible for
- 18 classes under Section 29.153(b)(1) [29.153];
- 19 (2) the numbers of half-day and full-day
- 20 prekindergarten classes offered by the district; and
- 21 (3) the sources of funding for the prekindergarten
- 22 classes.
- SECTION 4. Section 29.153(d), Education Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 25 school year.
- 26 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
