8	Sec. 21.4554. READING-TO-LEARN ACADEMIES. (a) The
9	commissioner shall develop and make available reading-to-learn
10	academies for teachers who provide reading comprehension
11	instruction to students at the fourth or fifth grade level.
12	(b) A reading-to-learn academy developed under this section
13	must:
14	(1) include effective instructional practices that
15	promote student development of reading comprehension and
16	inferential and critical thinking; and
17	(2) provide participating teachers with access to the
18	academy training materials through the Internet after the teachers
19	attend the academy.

- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
