A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation of regional military sustainability
3	commissions for certain military installations.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 397A.052(a), (b), and (c), Local
6	Government Code, are amended to read as follows:
7	(a) This section applies only to:
8	(1) a county:
9	(A) in which three or more locations of a joint
10	military base are located; and
11	(B) with a population of more than 1.7 million;
12	(2) a county that is adjacent to a county described by
13	Subdivision (1); and
14	(3) a municipality located in a county described by
15	Subdivision (1) or (2).
16	(b) One or more municipalities [A county with
17	unincorporated area located within five miles of the boundary line
18	of a military installation, and a municipality with a population of
19	1.1 million or more and] with extraterritorial jurisdiction located
20	within five miles of the boundary line of a military installation
21	and one or more counties with unincorporated area located within
22	five miles of the boundary of a military installation[, each of
23	which, with respect to the same military installation, constitutes
2.4	a defense community as defined by Section 397.001. may agree by

- 1 order, ordinance, or other means to establish and fund a regional
- 2 military sustainability commission under this subchapter with
- 3 respect to the military installation [in an area that is located:
- 4 [(1) in the same county as the active military
- 5 installation; and
- 6 [(2) in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the
- 7 municipality].
- 8 [(b) Defense communities may not establish more than one
- 9 commission in a county.
- 10 (c) \underline{A} [Except as provided by Subsection (d), a] commission's
- 11 territory consists of the [unincorporated] area:
- 12 (1) located outside the military installation's
- 13 boundaries and:
- 14 (A) within two miles of the boundary line of a
- 15 military installation, except as provided by Paragraph (B); or
- 16 (B) for a commission established for a military
- 17 installation engaged in flight training at the time the commission
- 18 is established, within a rectangle bounded by lines located no
- 19 farther than 1-1/2 statute miles from the centerline of a runway of
- 20 the installation and lines located no farther than five statute
- 21 miles from each end of the paved surface of a runway of the
- 22 <u>installation;</u>
- 23 <u>(2) located in:</u>
- 24 (A) the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a
- 25 participating municipality; or
- 26 (B) the unincorporated area of a participating
- 27 county; and

- 1 $\underline{(3)}$ designated as the commission's territory when the
- 2 commission is established.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 397A.052(d), Local Government Code, is
- 4 repealed.
- 5 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act do not affect
- 6 a regional military sustainability commission created under
- 7 Section 397A.052, Local Government Code, before the effective date
- 8 of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
