A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the eligibility requirements of a notary public.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 406.004, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 406.004. ELIGIBILITY. <u>(a)</u> Each person appointed and commissioned as a notary public shall be at least 18 years of age and a resident of the State of Texas and must not have been convicted of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude.

(b) If the secretary of state discovers, at any time, that applicant to be a notary public or a commissioned notary public is not eligible to serve as a notary public, the secretary of state shall:

(1) reject the notary application; or (2) revoke the notary commission.

SECTION 2. Section 406.009(d), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

In this section, "good cause" includes: (d) (1)[a final conviction for a crime

involving moral turpitude;
