A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the requirements for the casing and cementing of an oil

3 or gas well.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 91.011, Natural Resources Code, is

6 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to

7 read as follows:

- 8 (a) Before drilling into the oil or gas bearing rock, the
- 9 owner or operator of a well being drilled for oil or gas shall

10 encase the well with good and sufficient wrought iron or steel

11 casing $\underline{\,}$ or with any other material that meets standards adopted by

12 the commission, and cement the casing, particularly where wells

13 could be subjected to corrosive elements or high pressures and

14 temperatures, in a manner and to a depth that will exclude surface

15 or fresh water from the lower part of the well from penetrating the

16 oil or gas bearing rock, and if the well is drilled through the

17 first into the lower oil or gas bearing rock, the well shall be

18 <u>encased and cemented</u> [cased] in a manner and to a depth that will

19 exclude fresh water above the last oil or gas bearing rock

20 penetrated.

- 21 (a-1) A well drilled for oil or gas shall be encased with a
- 22 casing that is cemented to a depth of at least 50 feet below the base
- 23 of the deepest formation transected by the well that contains water
- 24 that is suitable as a source of drinking water supply.

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1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
