- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Section 225.106 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 225.106. SGT. TANNER STONE HIGGINS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.
- 9 (a) The portion of State Highway 154 from the municipal limits of
- 10 Yantis in Wood County north to the municipal limits of Sulphur
- 11 Springs in Hopkins County is designated as the Sgt. Tanner Stone
- 12 <u>Higgins Memorial Highway.</u>
- (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:
- 14 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
- 15 <u>designation as the Sgt. Tanner Stone Higgins Memorial</u> Highway and
- 16 any other appropriate information; and
- 17 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
- 18 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
