1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 154 in
 1-20 Wood and Hopkins Counties as the Sgt. Tanner Stone Higgins Memorial
 1-21 Highway.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-24 is amended by adding Section 225.106 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 225.106. SGT. TANNER STONE HIGGINS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

1-26 (a) The portion of State Highway 154 from the municipal limits of
 1-27 Yantis in Wood County north to the municipal limits of Sulphur
 1-28 Springs in Hopkins County is designated as the Sgt. Tanner Stone
 1-29 Higgins Memorial Highway.

1-30 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-31 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-32 designation as the Sgt. Tanner Stone Higgins Memorial Highway and
 1-33 any other appropriate information; and

1-34 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-35 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
