(a) A person who 7 is an officer or employee of the United States, this state, or a 8 political subdivision of this state commits an offense if the 9 person, while acting under color of the person's office or 10 employment, intentionally or knowingly seizes a firearm as 11 permitted or required by a federal statute, order, rule, or 12 regulation that imposes a prohibition, restriction, or other 13 14 regulation on firearms that does not exist under the laws of this state. 15 16 (b) For purposes of this section, a person acts under color of the person's office or employment if the person acts or purports 17 to act in an official capacity or takes advantage of such actual or 18 19 purported capacity. 20 (c) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor. 21 (d) It is an exception to the application of this section that the person's seizure of a firearm was consistent with an 22 23 explicit and applicable grant of federal statutory authority that is consistent with the United States Constitution. 24

(e) The prosecution may negate the existence of the 1 exception provided by Subsection (d) only by proving beyond a 2 reasonable doubt that, based on a decision entered by the United 3 4 States Supreme Court on or after September 1, 2015, the federal statute, order, rule, or regulation described by Subsection (a) is 5 6 not within the scope of federal powers conferred by the United 7 States Constitution. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8

If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
