- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 256.204, Estates Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 256.204. PERIOD FOR CONTEST. (a) After a will is
- 8 admitted to probate, an interested person may commence a suit to
- 9 contest the validity thereof not later than the first [second]
- 10 anniversary of the date the will was admitted to probate, except
- 11 that an interested person may commence a suit to cancel a will for
- 12 forgery or other fraud not later than the first [second]
- 13 anniversary of the date the forgery or fraud was discovered.
- 14 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), an incapacitated person
- 15 may commence the contest under that subsection on or before the
- 16 first [second] anniversary of the date the person's disabilities
- 17 are removed.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 19 256.204, Estates Code, apply only to a will admitted to probate on
- 20 or after the effective date of this Act. A will admitted to probate
- 21 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 22 effect on the date on which the will was admitted to probate, and
- 23 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
