1 AN ACT 2 relating to the development and maintenance of certain records and written policies of animal shelters and releasing agencies; 3 amending a provision subject to a criminal penalty. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 823, Health and Safety 7 Code, is amended to read as follows: CHAPTER 823. ANIMAL SHELTERS AND RELEASING AGENCIES 8 SECTION 2. Section 823.001, Health and Safety Code, 9 is amended by adding Subdivision (5) to read as follows: 10 11 (5) "Releasing agency" has the meaning assigned by 12 Section 828.001. SECTION 3. Section 823.003(e), Health and Safety Code, as 13 14 amended by S.B. No. 219, Acts of the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, is amended to read as follows: 15 (e) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human 16 Services Commission <u>shall</u> [may] require each person operating an 17 animal shelter to keep records as required by Section 823.010. The 18 board may require the animal shelter [of the date and disposition of 19 animals in its custody,] to maintain the records on the business 20 premises of the animal shelter $[\tau]$ and to make the records available 21 for inspection at reasonable times. 22 SECTION 4. Chapter 823, Health and Safety Code, is amended 23 by adding Section 823.010 to read as follows: 24

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1	Sec. 823.010. INTAKE AND DISPOSITION RECORDS FOR ANIMAL
2	SHELTERS AND RELEASING AGENCIES. (a) Each animal shelter or
3	releasing agency operated in this state shall prepare and maintain
4	records regarding the intake and disposition of animals in the care
5	of the shelter or agency, including:
6	(1) the total number of animals, categorized by
7	species, as dog, cat, or other, taken in by the animal shelter or
8	releasing agency and the reason an animal was taken in, including
9	whether the animal was:
10	(A) surrendered by the animal's owner;
11	(B) impounded as a stray;
12	(C) impounded for a reason other than being a
13	stray;
14	(D) confiscated;
15	(E) transferred to the shelter or agency from a
16	location in this state;
17	(F) transferred to the shelter or agency from a
18	location outside this state; or
19	(G) born in the shelter or under the care of the
20	agency;
21	(2) the number of animals at the animal shelter or
22	releasing agency on the last day of each month; and
23	(3) the disposition of each animal taken in by the
24	animal shelter or releasing agency, categorized by species,
25	including whether the animal:
26	(A) was adopted;
27	(B) was reclaimed by the animal's owner;

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1	(C) died in the shelter or under the care of the
2	agency;
3	(D) was transferred from the shelter or agency;
4	(E) was euthanized by the shelter or agency on a
5	decision made by the shelter or agency;
6	(F) was euthanized at the owner's request;
7	(G) was a cat returned to the field as part of a
8	sterilization program; or
9	(H) was lost or stolen while in the shelter's or
10	agency's care.
11	(b) An animal shelter or releasing agency shall monthly
12	prepare the records required by Subsection (a).
13	(c) An animal shelter or releasing agency shall maintain
14	records prepared under Subsection (a) until at least the third
15	anniversary of the date the record was prepared.
16	(d) An animal shelter or releasing agency shall make the
17	records required by this section available to the public.
18	SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
19	an animal taken in or disposed of by an animal shelter or releasing
20	agency or counted in the shelter's or agency's animal total on or
21	after the effective date of this Act.
22	SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
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
