4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 821, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 821.058 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 821.058. WRITTEN EUTHANASIA POLICY. An animal shelter
8	that has a policy of routinely euthanizing dogs based on the breed
9	or size of the dog must develop a written statement of the shelter's
10	euthanasia policy. A dog that is euthanized according to the policy
11	developed under this section must be included in the shelter's
12	record of disposition of animals required by Section 823.010.
13	SECTION 2. Chapter 823, Health and Safety Code, is amended
14	by adding Section 823.010 to read as follows:
15	Sec. 823.010. INTAKE AND DISPOSITION RECORDS. (a) Each
16	animal shelter operated in this state shall prepare and maintain
17	records regarding the intake and disposition of animals in the
18	shelter, including:
19	(1) the total number of animals, categorized by
20	species, as dog, cat, or other, taken in by the animal shelter and
21	the reason an animal was taken in, including whether the animal was:
22	(A) surrendered by the animal's owner;
23	(B) identified as a stray;
24	(C) impounded;

1	(D) confiscated;
2	(E) transferred to the shelter from a location in
3	this state;
4	(F) transferred to the shelter from a location
5	outside this state; or
6	(G) born in the shelter;
7	(2) the number of animals at the animal shelter on the
8	last day of each month; and
9	(3) the disposition of each animal taken in by the
10	animal shelter, categorized by species, including whether the
11	animal:
12	(A) was adopted;
13	(B) was reclaimed by the animal's owner;
14	(C) died in the shelter;
15	(D) was transferred to another shelter;
16	(E) was euthanized by the shelter on a decision
17	<pre>made by the shelter;</pre>
18	(F) was euthanized at the owner's request;
19	(G) was released into its natural habitat; or
20	(H) was lost while in the shelter's care.
21	(b) An animal shelter shall monthly prepare the records
22	required by Subsection (a).
23	(c) An animal shelter shall maintain records prepared under
24	Subsection (a) until at least the third anniversary of the date the
25	record was prepared.
