A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to designating January as Human Trafficking Prevention
3 Month.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
6 amended by adding Section 662.107 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 662.107. HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION MONTH.

8 (a) January is Human Trafficking Prevention Month to increase
9 awareness of human trafficking in an effort to encourage people to
10 alert authorities to any suspected incidents involving human
11 trafficking.

12 (b) Human Trafficking Prevention Month may be regularly
13 observed through appropriate activities in public schools and other
14 places to increase awareness and prevention of human trafficking.

15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
