4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 42.29, Tax Code, is amended to read as
6	follows:
7	Sec. 42.29. ATTORNEY'S FEES. (a) Subject to Subsection
8	(b), a $[A]$ property owner who prevails in an appeal to the court
9	under Section 42.25 or 42.26 $\underline{\text{or}}[\tau]$ in an appeal to the court of a
10	determination of an appraisal review board on a motion filed under
11	Section 25.25[ - or in an appeal to the court of a determination of
12	an appraisal review board of a protest of the denial in whole or in
13	part of an exemption under Section 11.17, 11.22, 11.23, 11.231, or
14	11.24] may be awarded reasonable attorney's fees. The amount of the
15	award may not exceed the greater of:

- 16 (1) \$15,000; or
- 17 (2) 20 percent of the total amount by which the 18 property owner's tax liability is reduced as a result of the appeal.
- 19 (b) <u>The</u> [Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the] amount of an 20 award of attorney's fees <u>under Subsection (a)</u> may not exceed the
- 21 lesser of:
- 22 (1) \$100,000; or
- 23 (2) the total amount by which the property owner's tax
- 24 liability is reduced as a result of the appeal.

- 1 (c) A property owner who prevails in an appeal to the court
- 2 of a determination of an appraisal review board of a protest of the
- 3 denial in whole or in part of an exemption under Section 11.17,
- 4 <u>11.22</u>, 11.23, 11.231, or 11.24 may be awarded reasonable attorney's
- 5 <u>fees.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to an appeal under Chapter 42, Tax Code, that is filed on or after
- 8 the effective date of this Act. An appeal under Chapter 42, Tax
- 9 Code, that is filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 10 governed by the law in effect on the date the appeal is filed, and
- 11 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
