21	[(4) the election for the members of the governing
22	board of a public junior college district in which the school
23	district is wholly or partly located].
24	SECTION 2. Sections 11.059(a) and (e), Education Code, are

1 amended to read as follows:

2 (a) A trustee of an independent school district serves a
3 term of [three or] four years.

4 (e) Not later than December 31, 2015 [2011], the board of 5 trustees may adopt a resolution changing the length of the terms of its trustees. The resolution must provide for staggered terms of 6 [either three or] four years and specify the manner in which the 7 8 transition from the length of the former term to the modified term is made. The transition must begin with the first regular election 9 for trustees that occurs after January 1, 2016 [2012], and a trustee 10 who serves on that date shall serve the remainder of that 11 12 term. This subsection expires January 1, 2021 [2017].

SECTION 3. Section 11.065(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

15 (a) Sections 11.052(g) and (h) and <u>Section</u> [Sections]
16 11.059(a) [and (b)] do not apply to the board of trustees of a
17 school district if:

(1) the district's central administrative office is
located in a county with a population of more than two million; and
(2) the district's student enrollment is more than

21 125,000 and less than 200,000.

SECTION 4. Section 11.059(b), Education Code, is repealed.
 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
