1-17 relating to time credits awarded against the cumulative period of
 1-18 commitment or treatment of certain defendants determined to be

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Article 46B.0095(d), Code of Criminal Procedure,
 1-22 as added by Chapter 822 (H.B. 2725), Acts of the 82nd Legislature,
 1-23 Regular Session, 2011, is repealed.

1-24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-25 to a defendant with respect to whom any proceeding under Chapter
 1-26 46B, Code of Criminal Procedure, is conducted on or after the
 1-27 effective date of this Act.

1-28 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
