A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to studies on the rates of electric utilities.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 36.210, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsections (h) and (i) and adding Subsection (h-1) to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (h) The commission shall undertake a study and conduct a
- 8 report analyzing any periodic rate adjustment established under
- 9 this section. The study shall be available for the legislature's
- 10 review by January 31, 2019 [2017], so that the legislature may
- 11 properly be informed as to the need to continue the commission's
- 12 authority to allow periodic rate adjustments. The report shall
- 13 contain but shall not be limited to:
- 14 (1) an analysis of all periodic rate adjustments
- 15 approved by the commission;
- 16 (2) an analysis of the amounts in real dollars and
- 17 percentages of the approved amounts by the commission and the
- 18 effects on all classes of ratepayers;
- 19 (3) the costs savings, if any, realized by all parties
- 20 by utilizing periodic rate adjustment as opposed to ratemaking
- 21 proceedings;
- 22 (4) an analysis on distribution costs included in
- 23 periodic rate adjustments, and their appropriateness for inclusion
- 24 in periodic rate adjustments; and

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- 1 (5) an analysis submitted by the office on the effects
- 2 of periodic rate adjustments.
- 3 (h-1) The commission shall conduct a study and make a report
- 4 analyzing alternative ratemaking mechanisms adopted by other
- 5 states and shall make recommendations regarding appropriate
- 6 reforms to the ratemaking process in this state. The commission
- 7 shall include in the report an analysis that demonstrates how the
- 8 commission's recommended reforms would improve the efficiency and
- 9 effectiveness of the oversight of electric utilities and ensure
- 10 that electric rates are just and reasonable, as required by this
- 11 chapter. The commission may retain an independent consultant, at
- 12 the expense of electric utilities, to conduct the study. The
- 13 commission shall provide the report to the legislature not later
- 14 than January 15, 2017.
- 15 (i) This section expires <u>September</u> [January] 1, <u>2019</u>
- 16 $[\frac{2017}{1}]$.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
