## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

 AN ACT	

- 2 relating to the duty of business entities to use an automated
- 3 external defibrillator.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 779, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 779.0061 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 779.0061. DUTY TO USE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL
- 8 DEFIBRILLATOR; CIVIL LIABILITY. (a) A business entity that
- 9 <u>advertises the presence of an automated external defibrillator and</u>
- 10 staff trained to use the automated external defibrillator shall use
- 11 the automated external defibrillator on a person in cardiac arrest
- 12 on property owned or rented by the business entity if necessary.
- 13 (b) If a business entity negligently fails to use an
- 14 automated external defibrillator under Subsection (a), the
- 15 business entity is liable for civil damages, including personal
- 16 injury and wrongful death, caused by the negligent failure to act.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
