- 2 (1) is in an open container, as defined by Section

- 4 (2) appears to be possessed for present consumption;
- 5 (3) remains within the confines of the facility,

- 7 (4) was purchased legally at a licensed or permitted
- 8 premises within the facility.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
