H.B. No. 2377

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the ability of a student who lived out of state in the
3 preceding school year to enroll full-time in courses provided
4 through the state virtual school network.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 30A.002(b), Education Code, is amended
7 to read as follows:

8 (b) A student is eligible to enroll full-time in courses
9 provided through the state virtual school network only if the
10 student:

11 (1) was enrolled in a public school [~~in this state~~] in
12 the preceding school year; or

13 (2) has been placed in substitute care in this state,
14 regardless of whether the student was enrolled in a public school
15 [~~in this state~~] in the preceding school year.

16 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
17 school year.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
22 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
