- 2 relating to the ability of a student who lived out of state in the
- 3 preceding school year to enroll full-time in courses provided
- 4 through the state virtual school network.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 30A.002(b), Education Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (b) A student is eligible to enroll full-time in courses
- 9 provided through the state virtual school network only if the
- 10 student:
- 11 (1) was enrolled in a public school [in this state] in
- 12 the preceding school year; or
- 13 (2) has been placed in substitute care in this state,
- 14 regardless of whether the student was enrolled in a public school
- 15 [in this state] in the preceding school year.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 17 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
