USE OF CERTAIN INFORMATION FOR FEDERAL 1 RECOGNITION OF EMISSIONS REDUCTIONS. 2 The commission, using information derived from the reports to the commission under 3 Sections 386.205, 388.003(e), [and] 388.006, and 388.013, shall 4 5 take all appropriate and necessary actions so that emissions reductions achieved by means of activities under Chapters 386 and 6 388 are credited by the United States Environmental Protection 7 8 Agency to the appropriate emissions reduction objectives in the state implementation plan. 9

10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
