A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the establishment of a residential energy efficiency
- 3 loan program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 386.252(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Money in the fund may be used only to implement and
- 8 administer programs established under the plan. Money
- 9 appropriated to the commission to be used for the programs under
- 10 Section 386.051(b) shall be allocated as follows:
- 11 (1) not more than four percent may be used for the
- 12 clean school bus program under Chapter 390;
- 13 (2) not more than three percent may be used for the new
- 14 technology implementation grant program under Chapter 391, from
- 15 which at least \$1 million will be set aside for electricity storage
- 16 projects related to renewable energy;
- 17 (3) five percent shall be used for the clean fleet
- 18 program under Chapter 392;
- 19 (4) not more than \$3 million may be used by the
- 20 commission to fund a regional air monitoring program in commission
- 21 Regions 3 and 4 to be implemented under the commission's oversight,
- 22 including direction regarding the type, number, location, and
- 23 operation of, and data validation practices for, monitors funded by
- 24 the program through a regional nonprofit entity located in North

- 1 Texas having representation from counties, municipalities, higher
- 2 education institutions, and private sector interests across the
- 3 area;
- 4 (5) not less than 16 percent shall be used for the
- 5 Texas natural gas vehicle grant program under Chapter 394;
- 6 (6) not more than five percent may be used to provide
- 7 grants for natural gas fueling stations under the clean
- 8 transportation triangle program under Section 394.010;
- 9 (7) not more than five percent may be used for the
- 10 Texas alternative fueling facilities program under Chapter 393;
- 11 (8) a specified amount may be used each year to support
- 12 research related to air quality as provided by Chapter 387;
- 13 (9) not more than \$200,000 may be used for a health
- 14 effects study;
- 15 (10) \$500,000 is to be deposited in the state treasury
- 16 to the credit of the clean air account created under Section
- 17 382.0622 to supplement funding for air quality planning activities
- 18 in affected counties;
- 19 (11) at least \$4 million and up to four percent to a
- 20 maximum of \$7 million, whichever is greater, is allocated to the
- 21 commission for administrative costs;
- 22 (12) at least two percent and up to five percent of the
- 23 fund is to be used by the commission for the drayage truck incentive
- 24 program established under Subchapter D-1;
- 25 (13) not more than five percent may be used for the
- 26 light-duty motor vehicle purchase or lease incentive program
- 27 established under Subchapter D;

- 1 (14) not more than \$216,000 is allocated to the
- 2 commission to contract with the Energy Systems Laboratory at the
- 3 Texas Engineering Experiment Station annually for the development
- 4 and annual computation of creditable statewide emissions
- 5 reductions obtained through wind and other renewable energy
- 6 resources for the state implementation plan;
- 7 (15) 1.5 percent of the money in the fund is allocated
- 8 for administrative costs incurred by the laboratory; [and]
- 9 (15-a) not less than \$3 million shall be used for the
- 10 energy efficiency loan guarantee program under Section 388.013; and
- 11 (16) the balance is to be used by the commission for
- 12 the diesel emissions reduction incentive program under Subchapter C
- 13 as determined by the commission.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 388, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 15 by adding Section 388.013 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 388.013. ENERGY EFFICIENCY LOAN GUARANTEE PROGRAM.
- 17 (a) The comptroller and the State Energy Conservation Office by
- 18 rule shall establish and administer a program that issues or
- 19 guarantees loans to be used for improvements that increase the
- 20 energy efficiency of residences that are not newly constructed.
- 21 (b) Rules adopted under this section must establish
- 22 eligibility requirements for receipt of a loan issued or guaranteed
- 23 under this section, including emissions reduction
- 24 cost-effectiveness criteria.
- 25 (c) The State Energy Conservation Office shall annually
- 26 submit to the commission and the laboratory a report that:
- 27 (1) evaluates the effectiveness of the program

- 1 <u>established under this section; and</u>
- 2 (2) quantifies energy savings and emissions
- 3 reductions as a result of this program for consideration in the
- 4 state implementation plan for emissions reduction credit.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 389.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 389.002. USE OF CERTAIN INFORMATION FOR FEDERAL
- 8 RECOGNITION OF EMISSIONS REDUCTIONS. The commission, using
- 9 information derived from the reports to the commission under
- 10 Sections 386.205, 388.003(e), [and] 388.006, and 388.013, shall
- 11 take all appropriate and necessary actions so that emissions
- 12 reductions achieved by means of activities under Chapters 386 and
- 13 388 are credited by the United States Environmental Protection
- 14 Agency to the appropriate emissions reduction objectives in the
- 15 state implementation plan.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
