## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of the board of directors of the Texas
- 3 Windstorm Insurance Association.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 2210.102(a), (c), (f), and (g),
- 6 Insurance Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The board of directors is composed of 11 [nine] members
- 8 appointed by the governor [commissioner] in accordance with this
- 9 section.
- 10 (c) Six [Four] members must, as of the date of the
- 11 appointment, reside in the first tier coastal counties. One
- 12 least one] of the members appointed under this subsection must be a
- 13 property and casualty agent who is licensed under this code and is
- 14 not a captive agent. Other members appointed under this subsection:
- 15 (1) must be association policyholders nominated by the
- 16 office of public insurance counsel; and
- 17 (2) may not be property and casualty agents.
- 18 (f) Insurers who are members of the association shall
- 19 nominate, from among those members, persons to fill any vacancy in
- 20 the four board of director seats reserved for representatives of
- 21 the insurance industry. The board of directors shall solicit
- 22 nominations from the members and submit the nominations to the
- 23 governor [commissioner]. The nominee slate submitted to the
- 24 governor [commissioner] under this subsection must include at least

- 1 three more names than the number of vacancies. The governor
- 2 [commissioner] shall appoint replacement insurance industry
- 3 representatives from the nominee slate.
- 4 (g) The governor [commissioner] shall appoint one person to
- 5 serve as a nonvoting member of the board to advise the board
- 6 regarding issues relating to the inspection process. The governor
- 7 [commissioner] may give preference in an appointment under this
- 8 subsection to a person who is a qualified inspector under Section
- 9 2210.254. The nonvoting member appointed under this subsection
- 10 [section] must:
- 11 (1) be an engineer licensed by, and in good standing
- 12 with, the Texas Board of Professional Engineers;
- 13 (2) reside in a first tier coastal county; and
- 14 (3) be knowledgeable of, and have professional
- 15 expertise in, wind-related design and construction practices in
- 16 coastal areas that are subject to high winds and hurricanes.
- SECTION 2. Sections 2210.103(a) and (c), Insurance Code,
- 18 are amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) Members of the board of directors serve <u>two-year</u>
- 20 [three-year staggered] terms[, with the terms of three members
- 21 expiring on the third Tuesday of March of each year].
- (c) A member of the board of directors may be removed by the
- 23 governor [commissioner] with cause stated in writing and posted on
- 24 the association's website. The governor [commissioner] shall
- 25 appoint a replacement in the manner provided by Section 2210.102
- 26 for a member who leaves or is removed from the board of directors.
- 27 SECTION 3. (a) The board of directors of the Texas

- 1 Windstorm Insurance Association established under Section
- 2 2210.102, Insurance Code, as that section existed before amendment
- 3 by this Act, is abolished effective December 1, 2015.
- 4 (b) The governor shall appoint the members of the board of
- 5 directors of the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association under
- 6 Section 2210.102, Insurance Code, as amended by this Act, not later
- 7 than December 1, 2015.
- 8 (c) The term of a person who is serving as a member of the
- 9 board of directors of the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association
- 10 immediately before the abolition of that board under Subsection (a)
- 11 of this section expires on December 1, 2015. Such a person is
- 12 eligible for appointment by the governor to the new board of
- 13 directors of the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association, subject to
- 14 the requirements of Section 2210.102, Insurance Code, as amended by
- 15 this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
