- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 33.04(b), Tax Code, as added by Chapter
- 6 935 (H.B. 1597), Acts of the 83rd Legislature, Regular Session,
- 7 2013, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) A notice of delinquency must contain the following
- 9 statement in capital letters: "THE TAXES ON THIS PROPERTY ARE
- 10 DELINQUENT. THE PROPERTY IS SUBJECT TO A LIEN FOR THE DELINQUENT
- 11 TAXES. IF THE DELINQUENT TAXES ARE NOT PAID, THE LIEN MAY BE
- 12 FORECLOSED ON. IF THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THIS DOCUMENT IS YOUR
- 13 RESIDENCE HOMESTEAD, YOU SHOULD CONTACT THE (NAME OF TAXING UNIT)
- 14 REGARDING A RIGHT YOU MAY HAVE TO ENTER INTO AN INSTALLMENT
- 15 AGREEMENT DIRECTLY WITH THE (NAME OF TAXING UNIT) FOR THE PAYMENT OF
- 16 THESE TAXES. IF YOU ARE 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER OR ARE DISABLED, AND
- 17 YOU OCCUPY THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THIS DOCUMENT AS YOUR
- 18 RESIDENCE HOMESTEAD, YOU SHOULD CONTACT THE APPRAISAL DISTRICT
- 19 REGARDING ANY ENTITLEMENT YOU MAY HAVE TO A POSTPONEMENT IN THE
- 20 PAYMENT OF THESE TAXES."
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 33.04(b), Tax Code, as added by Chapter
- 22 967 (H.B. 1913), Acts of the 83rd Legislature, Regular Session,
- 23 2013, is repealed.
- SECTION 3. Section 33.045, Tax Code, is repealed.

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- 1 SECTION 4. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 2 over another Act of the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015,
- 3 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 4 codes.
- 5 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
